**AT APPROXIMATELY 8 P.M. WEDNESDAY, APRIL 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2016, WINNEBAGO COUNTY SHERIFFS POLICE RESPONDED TO AN AGGRAVATED VEHICULAR HIJACKING AT DOLLAR GENERAL, 1405 KISHWAUKEE STREET, IN ROCKFORD. POLICE SAY THREE SUSPECTS, TWO OF WHOM WERE ARMED WITH HANDGUNS, STOLE A DODGE CHARGER AT GUNPOINT. THE VICTIM DESCRIBED THE SUSPECTS AS TWO BLACK MALES AND A WHITE MALE.**

**WINNEBAGO COUNTY SHERIFF'S POLICE SPOTTED THE SUSPECT VEHICLE THREE DIFFERENT TIMES LATER IN THE EVENING. TWO PURSUITS ENDED QUICKLY WITHOUT ANY ARRESTS. THE THIRD PURSUIT IN SOUTHEAST ROCKFORD LASTED APPROXIMATELY 10 MINUTES AND REACHED MAXIMUM SPEEDS OF 90 MILES PER HOUR. POLICE DEPLOYED STOP STICKS AND OFFICERS WITH THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT TACTICAL UNIT LOCATED THE SUSPECT'S VEHICLE NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF 11<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND 7<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE. A SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT SQUAD CAR AND THE SUSPECT'S VEHICLE SUSTAINED DAMAGE AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE PURSUIT.**

**TWO SUSPECTS WERE TREATED FOR MINOR INJURIES AT A LOCAL HOSPITAL AND RELEASED. TWO OTHER SUSPECTS REMAIN AT LARGE. THE TWO CAPTURED SUSPECTS ARE CHARGED WITH THE FOLLOWING CRIMINAL OFFENSES:**
