BETWEEN APRIL 8, 2016 AND APRIL 12, 2016, WINNEBAGO COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES TOOK REPORTS OF TWO RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES AND SEVERAL VEHICLE BURGLARIES THAT OCCURRED IN THE NORTHEAST PART OF UNINCORPORATED ROSCOE, IN RURAL WINNEBAGO COUNTY.
