The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office Releases Halloween Enforcement Crackdown Numbers

Winnebago County, IL — "The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office made 1 impaired driving arrests and issued 13 seat belt citations during the recent Halloween Crackdown," said Deputy Chief Dominick Barcellona. The following are the other results of the Halloween Crackdown: 16 citations issued for various violations, 2 speeding citations, 7 uninsured motorists, 3 drug related arrests, 1 warrant served, and 1 person arrested for driving with a suspended or revoked drivers license.

Law enforcement agencies throughout Illinois participated in this effort to save lives by getting impaired drivers off our roads and more people buckled up during Halloween.

Extra emphasis was given to the late-night hours, when statistics show the most unbuckled and impaired driving fatalities occur.

The recent law enforcement crackdown was made possible by federal traffic safety funds through the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of the statewide "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Click It or Ticket" campaigns.
