A HOLIDAY SEASON REMINDER: THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE SAYS DRIVE SOBER OR GET PULLED OVER.

THE WINNEBAGO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IS PARTNERING WITH THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER THANKSGIVING TO STOP DRUNK DRIVERS AND HELP SAVE LIVES.

The high visibility "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" crackdown runs through November 28th. During this period, law enforcement agencies across Illinois will show zero tolerance for impaired driving and seat belt law violators. Increased state and national messaging about the dangers of drunk and drugged driving and beefed up police patrols aim to reduce impaired driving locally and nationwide.
