WINNEBAGO COUNTY SHERIFF GARY CARUANA HAS ISSUED A TEMPORARY NO WAKE ORDER FOR THE ENTIRE ROCK RIVER IN WINNEBAGO COUNTY UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. THE SHERIFF SAYS RIVER LEVELS ARE RISING DUE TO HEAVY RAINFALL LAST NIGHT AND THIS MORNING. SHERIFF CARUANA NOTES ADDITIONAL RAINFALL IS EXPECTED DURING THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS.
