INFORMATION: TRAFFIC STOP MACHESNEY PARK LEADS TO GUN AND CANNABIS RECOVERY

On Tuesday January 9th, 2018 at 10:31 pm, a Traffic stop was performed on a vehicle at Orlando and Rt-173 in Machesney Park, Il by Sheriff's Deputies of the Machesney Park Division for traffic violations.

The driver of the Vehicle was identified as 20 year old John Kaczmarek of Wonder Lake, il. Sheriff's deputies discovered Kaczmarek had a suspended Driver's license as well as the vehicle he was driving had no insurance.

A subsequent search of the vehicle revealed a loaded handgun and a vacuum sealed bag containing cannabis.

Kaczmarek was arrested and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail on charges of Aggravated Unlawful use of a Weapon, No Firearms Owner Identification, Possession of Cannabis 10-30 grams and several traffic citations.

The charges against Kaczmarek are merely accusations and he is considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
