On Friday March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 2:00 Pm, Winnebago County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a Burglary in progress at 1400 Temple Circle in unincorporated Winnebago County. (This address is located in the Newburg Rd & South Bell school area.)

Neighbors in the area observed the suspect forcibly enter a residence in the area at which time the suspect was confronted by a neighbor. The subject then fled the area on a bicycle.

The suspect in the incident is described as a White Male, age 50's, approximately 6'0" 200 Lbs. The suspect has gray straight hair and a goatee.

The suspect was wearing a black leather coat and hat and was wearing high top tennis shoes and blue jeans.

Suspect fled the area on a black bicycle with white lettering.
