On Saturday, June 23, 2018, at approximately 11:00 p.m., the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department responded to a 911 call from the 2600 block of Bilbury Drive for a missing adult. The caller reported that his 21 year old girlfriend left their home at 6:00 p.m. to go for a walk. The caller reported that the missing female had a history of seizures.

A Sheriff's K9 unit was dispatched to the area and conducted a search of the area for the missing female. Deputy Thomas Warmoth and his K9, Ares, began a search from the home which led to the entrance of Atwood Park in New Milford. The missing female was located approximately 2 miles from home. The K9's track led to the wood line in the park where the missing female was located, alive and semi-conscious, having a medical episode.

The female was transported to Swedish American Hospital by New Milford Ambulance, where she was treated for her undisclosed condition.
