Winnebago County Sheriff Gary Caruana is urging boaters to exercise caution while boating or using the Rock River for water activities.

Due to a lower than normal expected river level, current conditions at the Rock River Latham Park are 4.7 ft. Rockford Fordham dam is currently at 2.22 ft.

Com-Ed will be working to repair the malfunctioning gates at the Fordham Dam in the near future.

Sheriff Caruana advises that the Rock River remains open; however users should exercise extreme caution for debris and low levels of the river.
