In a Memorandum issued today October 22nd, 2019 by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources reads in part:

Northwest Zone Commander Laura Petreikis and District 6 Sergeant Phillip Wire report that conditions prompting the boating restrictions on the Rock River and Pecatonica River are no longer significant. Winnebago County Sheriff Gary Caruana concurs.

Effective October 22nd, 2019 at 7:00 p.m, the restricted boating conditions on both rivers have been lifted.

Winnebago County Sheriff Gary Caruana has issued a no wake order for the Rock River until further notice.
