On February 8, 2020 at approximately 11:04 p.m., members of the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police Tac team conducted a traffic stop on a silver sedan occupied by 4 men in the 400 block of North Day Avenue. The driver of the car, later identified as Malcolm Turner, stopped his car in the driveway of a nearby residence and jumped out of the driver's seat. Deputies ordered Turner to walk toward them but Turner took off running. One deputy chased Turner on foot while another deputy remained with the other occupants of the car. During the foot chase, a deputy saw Turner discard a black handgun before catching him and placing him under arrest. The discarded handgun was found and recovered. Deputies searched Turner's car and recovered a second handgun from underneath the driver's seat of Turner's car.

Malcolm Turner was charged with aggravated unlawful use of a weapon, unlawful possession of a weapon by a felon and resisting a peace officer and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.

Malcolm Turner is innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
