Rockford Man Arrested After Narcotics Investigation

For the past several months, the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department Narcotics Unit has been investigating the sale of Fentanyl to individuals at various locations within Winnebago County. On June 11, 2020, the suspect, Demardicus W. Henry, 28 was taken into custody in the 5600 Block of Wansford Way in Rockford. Henry was found to be in possession of an amount of Fentanyl and Ecstasy Tablets. The investigation led deputies to a residence in the 2100 block of Charles Street. During a search of the residence, deputies located a large amount of United States currency and a firearm. The firearm was found to be stolen out of Oak Lawn, Illinois. The Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following charges:

Demardicus W. Henry (DOB: 03/11/1992) of Rockford, Illinois

- Unlawful Use of Weapons by a Felon
- Possession of a Stolen Firearm
- Possession with Intent to Deliver Ecstasy
- Possession with Intent to Deliver Fentanyl
- Delivery of Fentanyl

The charges against Demardicus W. Henry are merely allegations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
