Two Arrested After Multiple Residential Burglaries in Winnebago County

Winnebago County Sheriff's Police have responded to several residential burglaries that have occurred in recent days in various areas of Winnebago County. Detectives launched an investigation and obtained information from the community that lead to a suspect in these burglaries. On April 7, 2021, detectives observed the suspects Bobby Hare and Brooke Jones commit a Residential Burglary in the 5800 block of Dover Road in unincorporated Winnebago County. Hare and Jones were taken into custody. The Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following charges:

Bobby D. Hare (DOB: 12/1/1975) of Rockford

- Residential Burglary
- Possession of a Stolen Vehicle
- Resisting/Obstructing a Peace Officer
- · Driving While Driver's License Revoked

Brook I. Jones (DOB: 04/20/1992) of Rockford
