Rockford Man Arrested After Narcotics Investigation

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Police received complaints from the community regarding a subject dealing narcotics. During the investigation that individual was identified as Jeremi I. Nelson.

On Monday October 4, 2021, the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department Narcotics Unit took Nelson into custody in the area of N. 2nd Street and Y Boulevard. Nelson was found to be in possession of cocaine, fentanyl and a large amount United States Currency.

The Winnebago County States Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following Class 1 Felony charges:

Jeremi I. Nelson, 28, of Rockford, IL

- · Unlawful Delivery of 1-15 grams of Cocaine
- Possession With Intent to Deliver 1-15 grams of Fentanyl
- Possession With Intent to Deliver 1-15 grams of Cocaine

The charges against Jeremi I. Nelson are merely allegations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
