### **Narcotics Investigation Ends in the Arrest of Two Rockford Men**

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Department had been receiving complaints regarding the sale of narcotics at various locations around Winnebago County. Detectives from the Narcotics Unit conducted an investigation and two individuals were developed as suspects in the sales. During the investigation, deputies observed Detrayvian D. Jones and Derick O. Gulley conduct a suspected drug transaction from inside a black SUV near Jackson and Longwood Streets in Rockford. On August 13, 2020, at approximately 12:00pm, deputies and members of the Sheriff's Department TAC Team approached the SUV in the 1600 block of Rural Street. During a subsequent search of the vehicle and the occupants, Deputies located fentanyl, cocaine, cannabis, guns and multiple rounds of ammunition. The Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following charges:

#### **Detrayvian D. Jones (D.O.B. 11/23/1997) of Rockford, Illinois**

- Armed Habitual Criminal
- Armed Violence
- Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance (2 Counts)
- Delivery of a Controlled Substance
- Possession with Intent to Deliver Cannabis
- Unlawful Use of Weapons by a Felon

#### **Derrick O. Gully (D.O.B 10/24/1996) of Rockford, Illinois**

- Armed Violence
- Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance
- Unlawful Use of Weapons by a Felon

The charges against Detrayvian D. Jones and Derrick O. Gulley are merely allegations and both suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
