Rockford Man Arrested After Narcotics Investigation

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Department has been receiving complaints from the community regarding a subject dealing narcotics in the 800 block of Sawyer Road. After an investigation, a residence was identified as being the source of the narcotics complaint. On July 16, 2020, at approximately 1:15pm, members of the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department Narcotics Unit attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the suspect, Mark Dahlberg, as he left the residence. Dahlberg fled from Deputies but he was taken in to custody a short time later upon his return to the residence. While taking Dahlberg into custody, Deputies observed him throw a bag that contained cocaine. During a search of the residence Deputies located, Cocaine, Ecstasy, Adderall, Alprazolam, Hydrocodone, and narcotics packaging materials. Dahlberg is currently on parole from the Illinois Department of Corrections for a narcotics charge. The Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following charges:

Mark J. Dahlberg (DOB: 06/30/75) of Rockford, Illinois

- Possession with Intent to Deliver Cocaine (1-15 grams) (2 counts)
- Delivery of Cocaine (1-15 grams)
- Possession with Intent to Deliver Cannabis (30-500 grams)
- Aggravated Fleeing to Elude
- Possession of a Controlled Substance (4 counts)
- Resisting a Police Officer

The charges against Mark J. Dahlberg are merely allegations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
