ROCKFORD MAN CHARGED WITH MULTIPLE DRUG CHARGES

In June 2025, members of the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department Narcotics Unit began receiving information on a subject selling fentanyl and crack cocaine in the Rockford area. During this investigation, they identified the individual as Rodney Q. Clark of Rockford. On Tuesday, July 22nd, after observing Clark make a drug transaction in the 500 block of East Jefferson Street, he was taken into custody. After Clark was taken into custody, Deputies located fentanyl and crack cocaine in his vehicle.

The investigation led to a residence in the 1600 block of Columbia Avenue in Rockford where a search warrant was executed. During the execution of the search warrant, deputies located 190 grams of fentanyl, 116 grams of heroin, 27 grams of crack cocaine, an amount of marijuana, and drug packaging materials. Deputies also located 3 firearms and a large amount of United States currency. It was learned that Rodney Clark is a convicted felon. The Winnebago County States Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following charges:

Rodney Q. Clark (age 50) of Rockford, IL.

- Possession with Intent to Deliver 100-400 grams of Fentanyl
- Possession with Intent to Deliver 100-400 grams of Heroin
- Possession with Intent to Deliver 15-100 grams of Cocaine
- Possession with Intent to Deliver 500-2,000 grams of Cannabis
- Unlawful Use of Weapons by a Felon (3 counts)
- Delivery of a Controlled Substance (2 counts)

The charges against **Rodney Q. Clark** are merely accusations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
