Rockford Man Charged with Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer

On September 13, 2024 at approximately 11:00a.m., Winnebago County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a domestic violence incident in the 1300 block of Bond Ave. Upon Deputies arrival, a male, later identified as Jimmy Honeycutt, was seen outside leaving the residence. After a short struggle with Deputies, Honeycutt was taken into custody. Two Deputies and the suspect were injured during the struggle and transported to a local hospital with minor injuries.

The Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of this case and authorized the following charges:

Jimmy L. Honeycutt, (37 years of age) of Rockford, IL.

- · 2-counts Resisting Arrest
- 2-counts Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer
- Attempting to Disarm a Peace Officer

The charges against Jimmy L. Honeycutt are merely accusations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
