Illinois Sheriff's Association Announces Scholarships

The Illinois Sheriff's Association announces that it will be awarding over \$58,000 in college scholarships throughout the State of Illinois to students wishing to pursue higher education in the 2025-2026 academic year. The scholarships are to be applied to tuition, books and fees only. The student must be enrolled full-time at a certified institution of higher learning within the State of Illinois, full-time online learning at an Illinois-based school is also acceptable.

Winnebago County Sheriff Gary Caruana will be awarding a scholarships in the amount \$500.00. There will be no restrictions on any applicant by reason of race, age, creed, color, sex or national origin. The only limitations are as follows:

- Applicants must be permanent Illinois residents
- Scholarships must be utilized at institutions of higher learning within the State of Illinois, including those
 offering online learning.
- Students must be enrolled as a full-time student during the 2025-2026 school year (excluding summer session).

Applications are now available at the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office or on the ISA Website https://www.ilsheriff.org/youth-2/. Students must complete the application, answer the essay question and return all documentation to the Sheriff's office in their permanent county of residence by March 14, 2025 (must be postmarked by this date).
