NARCOTICS ARREST

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Unit has recently concluded a thorough investigation into illegal narcotics sales within the 500 block of 11th Street, Rockford, IL. The focal point of this operation was the identification of Kevin N. Boose as the suspected individual involved.

On Wednesday, November 8th, 2023, the Winnebago County Narcotics Unit, in collaboration with the Regional Crime Deterrence Unit, successfully apprehended Kevin Boose during a suspected narcotics transaction in the 1400 block of 5th Avenue.

A subsequent follow-up operation at a residence in the 1400 block of 5th Avenue resulted in the discovery of a substantial quantity of illicit substances, including methamphetamine, fentanyl, and cocaine.

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office remains committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of our community by actively addressing and combating illegal drug activities. The collaborative efforts of the Narcotics Unit and the Regional Crime Deterrence Unit underscore the dedication to maintaining a safe community all residents.

The Winnebago County States Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following charges:

Kevin N. Boose (41 years old) of Rockford, IL

- MANUFACTURE/DELIVER 15<100 GRAMS FENTANYL - CLASS X
- MANUFACTURE/DELIVER METH DELIVERY/900+ GRAMS – CLASS X
- MANUFACTURE/DELIVER 100<400 GRAMS COCAINE – CLASS X

The charges against Kevin N. Boose are merely accusations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law
