In May of 2022, the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police Narcotics Unit received information from the community regarding a subject dealing large quantities of Fentanyl and Cocaine in the Rockford area. During this investigation, Sheriff's Police Narcotics Unit identified D'Anglo Patterson as the suspect.

On Thursday, June 23, 2022, the Winnebago County Sheriff's Police Narcotics Unit executed a search warrant at Patterson's residence. The residence is located in the 1800 block of 23<sup>rd</sup> St. Patterson was taken into custody at the residence at the time of the search warrant. Located during the search of the residence was over 30 grams of Fentanyl, over 40 grams of Crack Cocaine, two loaded handguns (one being stolen) as well as a large amount of United States Currency.

The Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of this case and authorized the following charges:

**D'Anglo D. Patterson (DOB: 04/05/1993) of Rockford, IL**

- 1 count of Possession with intent to deliver 15-100 grams of Cocaine. (Class X Felony)
- 1 count of Possession with intent to deliver 15-100 grams of Fentanyl (Class X Felony)
- 1 count of Armed Habitual Criminal (Class X Felony)
- 1 count of Unlawful use of Weapon by a Felon (Class 2 Felony)
- 1 count of Possession of Stolen Firearm (Class 2 Felony)
- 2 counts of Delivery of a Controlled Substance (Class 2 Felony)
- 1 count of Resisting an Officer (Class A misdemeanor)

The charges against D'Anglo Patterson are merely accusations and he is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
