SHERIFF CARUANA URGES COMMUNITY TO TAKE ACTION AGAINST DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office is investigating a tragic domestic murder-suicide that occurred in Roscoe on New Year's Day where a victim tragically lost her life at the hands of the suspect, who then took his own life.

Sheriff Gary Caruana emphasized that while this heartbreaking loss cannot be undone, such tragedies can be prevented. "Our hearts go out to the victim's family and loved ones during this difficult time. Preventing domestic violence requires the entire community to work together. From raising awareness in schools and workplaces to providing resources and safe spaces for victims, we all have a role to play. It's crucial that we educate everyone on healthy relationships, offer support to those in need, and foster an environment where abuse is not tolerated. The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office is dedicated to continuing to raise awareness, provide resources to those affected by domestic violence and create a safe community for everyone."
