Two People Arrested After Narcotics Investigation

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Department had received complaints regarding the sale of narcotics at multiple different locations within Winnebago County. Deputies from the Narcotics Unit began an investigation and developed a suspect in the sale. On August 19, 2020 at approximately 2:30pm, Deputies observed a drug transaction being conducted from inside of a vehicle in the 3100 block of 11th Street in Rockford. Deputies and members of the TAC Team followed the suspect vehicle to a gas station located on Airport Drive. The driver, later identified as Michael M. Mallett, exited the vehicle and was taken into custody inside the gas station. A front seat female passenger, Adriana Jimenez, was also taken into custody. DCFS took custody of two young children, ages 1 and 3, who were in the backseat of the vehicle. During a search of the vehicle, Deputies located fentanyl and a loaded full automatic handgun. The Winnebago County State's Attorney's Office reviewed the facts of the case and authorized the following charges:

Michael M. Mallett (DOB: 7/19/1997) of Rockford, Illinois

- · Unlawful Use of Weapons
- Armed Violence
- · Delivery of a Controlled Substance
- Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance
- Unlawful Use of Weapons by a Felon
- Endanger Life/Health of a Child (2 Counts)

Adriana A. Jimenez (DOB: 7/28/2000) of Rockford, Illinois

- Possession with Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance
- Endanger Life/Health of a Child
- · Resisting a Peace Officer

The charges against Michael M. Mallett and Adriana A. Jimenez are merely allegations and both suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
